- ✿ Conductive Education is an intensive, multi-disciplinary approach to education for children and adults with motor challenges. It combines educational lesson plans with physical activities.
- ✿ Developed in 1948 by Dr. Andras Peto in Hungary, it is based on the belief that people with motor disabilities can learn and develop physical movement, speech and mental ability by creating new neurological pathways to

Goals of Conductive Education

The goal of Conductive Education is to help the person participate in age appropriate activities and typical environments more independently. It promotes independence and encourages personality development. People that participate in these programs learn to solve problems on their own and it helps them to build self esteem and social skills. They also are healthier due to the holistic approach.

Who is a Candidate for Conductive Education?

- ✿ Children and adults—birth to 99 years old
- ✿ Those with neurological or motor disorders such as Cerebral Palsy, Spina Bifida, and traumatic brain injuries
- ✿ Must be cognitively able to comprehend and follow simple directions
